Primary and Secondary Recognition Languages: Within a Batch Type you can select two different OCR languages to be run on each document.

Primary and Secondary Locale: The locale is considered a subset of the recognition (OCR) language. In addition to accommodating regional vernacular, the system uses the locale settings to determine the default currency format, the data format, and for address parsing.

Date Display Format: This is used to force dates to comply with a specific format. The default value of the original, presents the date as it is found on the document. All other options will convert the date from the original format to the date format selected
